


Foxton Village Hall



A modern, imaginatively designed project, opened in 2002

FOXTON VILLAGE HALL

Foxton Village Hall - is a registered charity, No. 205434, administered and managed by a Committee of Management consisting of 6 elected representatives of the parish, 2 representatives of the Parish Council and representatives of regular user groups. The object of the charity is the provision and maintenance of a village hall for the use of the inhabitants of the parish of Foxton.

The **Foyer** is generously sized and gives access to all rooms and the toilet facilities. There is some low seating and a wheeled coat rail. A nappy changing table is located in the accessible toilet. The Foyer acts as an attractive reception area for weddings and other special occasions. It can also be used as an extended play area for childrens' groups.



The **Main Hall (150 sq m)** has a sealed wood floor, under floor heating, acoustic panels, a high ceiling, badminton court markings and induction loop plus amplification system with two microphones. Modular staging is available for creating a raised area of flexible height and area up to 28 sq. m. Maximum permitted number of people is 200 for dances. Seating capacity is about 120 people (with staging and tables, 100 people).



This makes it ideal for hire for indoor sports and for functions where high quality acoustics are important, such as dances, lectures or drama. There are double doors to the adjoining lounge room. By hiring the lounge as well, the hirer can use the bar and other refreshment facilities.

The **Meeting Room** (8.5m x 12.5m, low ceiling) has a non-slip vinyl floor. It can be divided into 2 smaller areas with a folding partition and there is a hatch to the kitchen. Maximum permitted number of people is 120 for dances. Seating capacity is about 80 people. This room has an induction loop with a microphone. This room is light and airy and by virtue of the partition, is extremely flexible. Double doors to paved area with low fencing and recreation ground beyond.



It is ideal for hire by large groups who do not need the space available in the main hall or by small groups needing a more intimate atmosphere e.g. childrens' parties, meetings with visiting speaker and band practise.



The **Lounge (56 sq m)** is mainly carpeted and has upholstered chairs at round tables. There is a hatch to the kitchen and a bar area with a non-slip vinyl floor . The maximum permitted capacity is 50 people. This is a small room ideal for committee meetings or, hired as an addition to the main hall acts as an ideal refreshment area with access to the kitchen . The bar has been designed to allow caterers to set up a full range of drinks and refreshments. There is an additional wheeled coat rack in this area.



The **Kitchen** is fully fitted with two built in electric fan ovens (one single, one double oven/grill), induction hob, microwave oven, a large larder fridge, double sink and drainers, separate hand wash basin and a 30 cup capacity hot water dispenser. There are domestic size saucepans, kettles, large teapots, plus assorted crockery and cutlery to serve approx. 120 people. There are hatches to the Meeting Room and Lounge. Its position makes the kitchen ideal for managing the catering for functions in all areas of the hall. Use of the kitchen is included in the hire of other rooms.

All rooms have both main overhead lights and soft lighting, also gas powered heating (included in the hire charge). Store rooms in the Main Hall and Meeting Room contain ample long tables and chairs for each room. Additional small tables are stored in the Foyer. The entire building is a NO SMOKING AREA. The public entertainment licence permits music and dance and all events must end no later than midnight. There are 25 parking spaces in front of the building and a free car park is located off the access road. The school playground or field may be made available for overflow parking by arrangement with the school (Tel. 01223 712447).



The **Sports Pavillion** adjoins the Village Hall but is self contained. There are separate home and visitor team changing rooms and showers, as well as separate changing room, toilet and shower for officials. There is an accessible toilet with nappy changing facility.



The **Club Room** (10m x 7m, high ceiling) is hard floored with a large hatchway to the kitchen and two double doors opening onto the recreation ground. There are both long and small folding tables and stacking chairs, seating capacity 70 people.

The **Kitchen** has a large catering oven, double fridge and hot water dispenser. There are supplies of glasses, crockery and cutlery.

Lettings Policy:

Any part of the building is available for hire for any lawful purpose, but the Management Committee reserves the right to refuse a hiring without giving any reason. All hire is subject to the rules set by the Management Committee and the conditions pertaining to the public entertainments licence. Usually payment must be made in advance and for some events an additional deposit against damage may be required.
