William **Brazier** was born in 1776 in Foxton, Cambridgeshire, England.^{1,2} He
witnessed the marriage of Charles Adams and Alice Skinner on 14 October 1811 in
All Saints, Little Shelford

Robert **Everett** was born in 1821 in Foxton, Cambridgeshire, England.^{1,2} He was the
son of John Everett. Robert Everett married Elizabeth Everett, daughter of John
Everett, on 13 November 1840 in All Saints, Little Shelford

Ann **Warboys** was born circa 1835 in Foxton, Cambridgeshire, England.² She
appeared on the 1851 Census, as a servant, in the household of William Gifford
Wragg at High Street, Little Shelford

Katherine **Wright** was born in 1836 in Foxton, Cambridgeshire, England.¹ She
appeared on the 1851 Census in the household of Joseph Jennings at Church Street,
Little Shelford

I live in Melbourne Australia and am researching my family history, particularly my
Great, Great, Grandparents who came from Foxton.

James Wright (aged 21) and Ann Warboys (aged 28) were married on 28 Sept. 1848 at the Barrington Meeting House (Independants) and emmigrated to Port Phillip on the ship 'Ann Milne' in 1849 arriving on the 19 May. With them were their two daughters Elizabeth Wright (aged 7) and Susan Wright (aged 5). My Great, Grandfather Thomas Wright was born at sea on the journey and baptised in Melbourne in 1850.

The Australian death certificates for the above daughters Elizabeth Palmer (nee Wright) and Susan Hughes (nee Wright) both show James and Ann to be their parents but I am concerned that this may not be the case. I am trying to chase down the Birth or Baptism details of the two girls to confirm this. Is there anybody who could point me in the right direction as this is a significant loose end in my family history?

Ann Warboys is I believe the sister of Susan Warboys already mentioned on the website.

Thomas Wright (aged 19), Jame's brother (above) and Eliza Newman (aged 18), also from Foxton, were married at the Barrington Meeting House on 22 Sept.1855 and the emmigrated to Hobsons Bay on the ship 'Calliance' arriving on the 31 Dec. 1855.

Using the 1841 Census I have been able to confirm the 'Place' of the Warboys was listed as Foxton Street. Is their any more detailed information as to where the Wright family actually lived in or near Foxton. ie James (c. 41) and Mary (c. 40) Wright, Elijah (c.19), James (above c.13), Thomas (above c.6), etc.

There are very large 'families' of Wright descendents living in Australia from this lineage.

I hope that this information will help supplement the emigration details already available.
